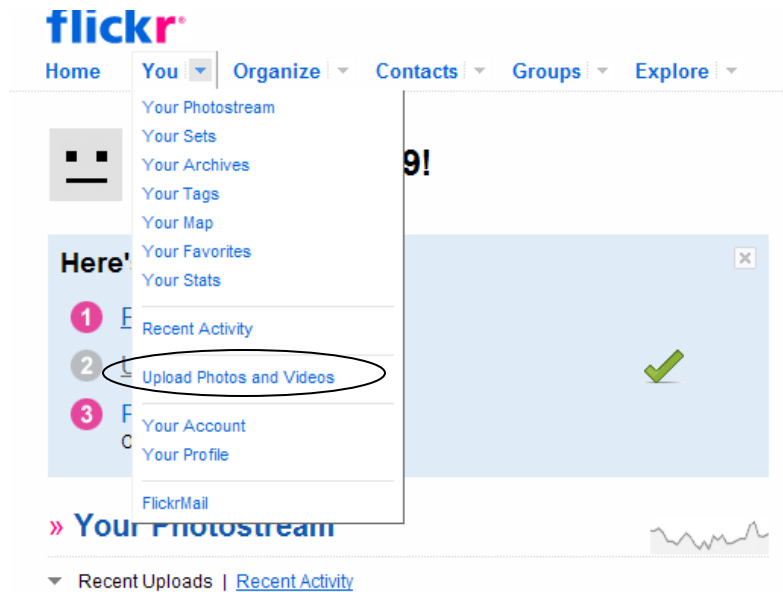


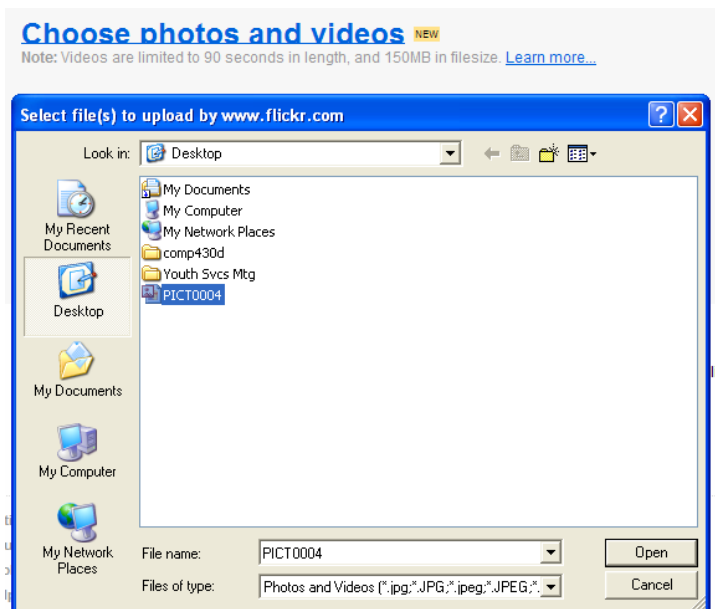
# Upload Pictures to Flickr

## Flickr.com

1. Login to your Flickr account.
2. On menu click You and then Upload Photos and Videos.

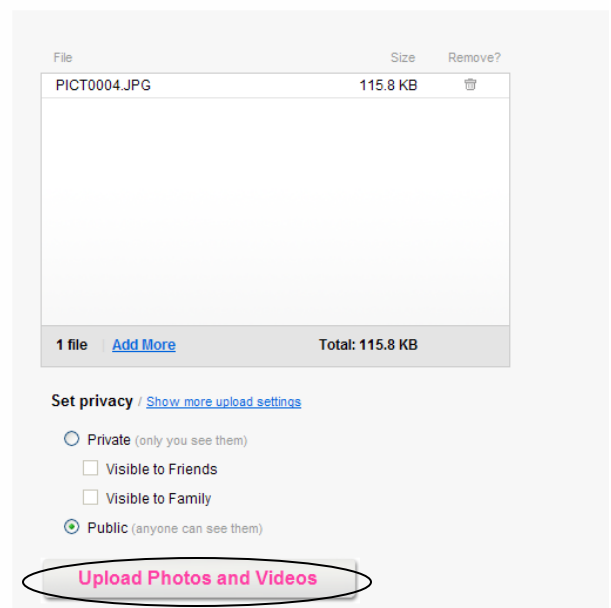


3. Click **Choose Photos and Videos**, select the photo(s) you want to download and click **Open**.

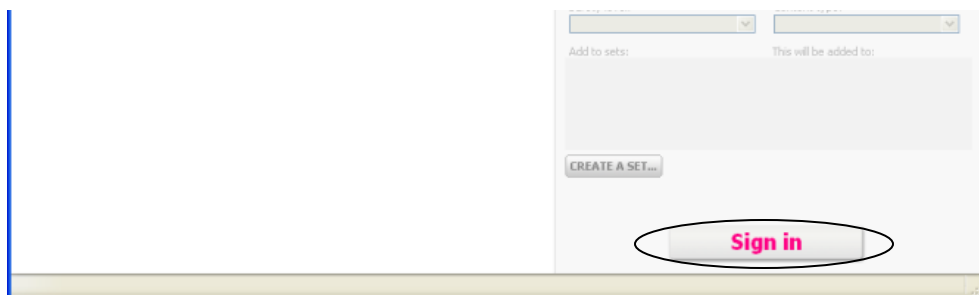


4. Click Open and then click Upload Photos and Videos

# Upload Pictures to Flickr

## Flickr Uploadr

1. Download and install the Flickr Uploadr on your computer. (Get it from <http://www.flickr.com/tools/>).
2. Start application (double-click Flickr Uploadr icon on desktop).
3. Click **Sign in**. You will then be prompted to log into your Flickr account and after logging in you need to click the **OK I'LL ALLOW IT** button to be able to use the Flickr Uploadr.



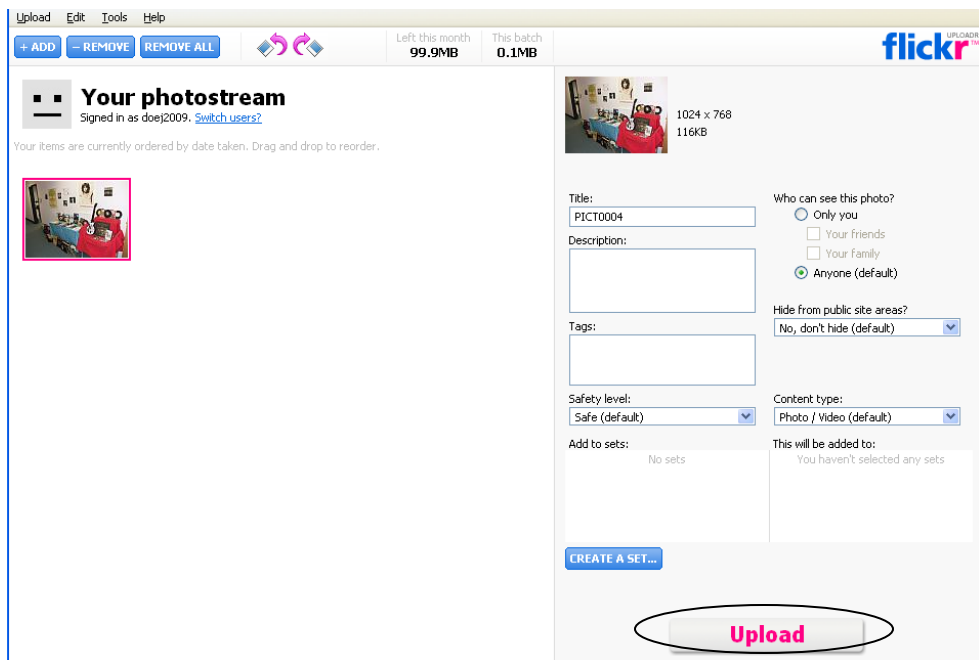
4. Click **Ready** button in

Flickr Uploadr. Note: You will now always be automatically signed in to your Flickr account when starting the application.

**When you've given the Flickr Uploadr permission to connect to your account on the Flickr website, click the big READY! button.**



5. You can now drag photos over to the Flickr Uploader application as well as add title, description and tags. Click **Upload** to upload picture to your Flickr account.



# Upload Pictures to Flickr

## Email

You can also email photos to your Flickr account via your private email upload address. This can be found at <http://www.flickr.com/tools/> (you will be prompted to login to your account). The subject of the email will be the picture title and the contents of the email will be the description.
