GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

This is a level 3 full time professional position serving within the Division of Information Technology. The IT Systems & Network Specialist performs professional duties to ensure the effective and efficient operation of the Integrated Library System (ILS), supporting servers, clients, LANs, WANs, and Information Technology related projects.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THIS POSITION

This position assists in maintaining network connections, servers and desktop PC's; serving as an operator and technical support specialist.

Provides technical assistance, training support and consults in the selection, use and maintenance of system-related hardware and software.

Acts as troubleshooter for system WAN connections.

Supports networks and ILS operations to the desktop level in the public libraries.

Supports and troubleshoots zero clients, PCs, email applications and peripheral equipment. Assist with support for applications and software such as anti-virus, filtering, and email applications, active directory and group policy.

Assist with for planning and implementing server and network upgrades.

Works as part of an on-call rotation for urgent issues.

Other duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Associate Degree in IT or related field or appropriate system and network administration in an enterprise setting required.

Knowledge of WANs, LANs, virtualization technologies, and desktop support methods. Knowledge of HTML/Web-design preferred.
