OUTLINE OF MAJOR CHANGES

 - **As a result, total holdings data for FY2024 will be significantly less than FY2023.*
- One-on-One Programs have been added to Section 3: Library Programming.
- Circulation data for e-materials, (ebooks, audiobooks, e-magazines, and video) from the new questions in Section 5 of the FY2024 report, is now included in Section 4: Library Circulation. The data is grouped as E-Material Circulation.
- Library social media platform use has been added to Section 5: Library Promotion.
- Whistle Blower and Sexual Harassment policies, Minimum Standards, and Trustee Education have been added to Section 6: Library Governance.
- WiFi passwords have been removed, as most libraries now require a password for WiFi access.
- Library tabling has been removed from Section 3: Library Programming.

The *2023 Annual Statistical Report* is a summarization of all member library statistics for the most recent calendar year. The report is generated by the Southern Tier Library System (STLS) using web-based software provided by the New York State Library. If members would like additional information, please contact STLS. Understanding how other libraries operate can help directors and trustees develop and improve essential services. *Regulation 90.2 of the Commissioner of Education* lists *Standards for Registration of Public, Free Association and Indian Libraries* indicates how libraries should minimally operate in New York State. These *Minimum Standards* have been recently revised, and went into effect January 1, 2021. The State Education Department expects all members to meet these standards for charter status.

Regulation 90.2 of the Commissioner of Education
STANDARDS FOR REGISTRATION OF PUBLIC, FREE ASSOCIATION AND INDIAN LIBRARIES

A public, free association or Indian library seeking to register with the department on or after January 1, 2021 shall be registered with the department if it meets the registration standards set forth in this subdivision in a manner satisfactory to the commissioner. Any public, free association or Indian library that was registered by the department on or before December 31, 2020, shall meet the following registration requirements by January 1, 2021 to continue to be registered by the department:

- (1) is governed by written bylaws which define the structure and governing functions of the library board of trustees, and which shall be reviewed and re-approved by the board of trustees at least once every five years or earlier if required by law;
- (2) has a community-based, board-approved, written long-range plan of service developed by the library board of trustees and staff;
- (3) provides a board-approved written annual report to the community on the library's progress in meeting its mission, goals and objectives, as outlined in the library's long-range plan of service;
- (4) has board-approved written policies for the operation of the library, which shall be reviewed and updated at least once every five years or earlier if required by law;
- (5) annually prepares and publishes a board-approved, written budget, which enables the library to address the community's needs, as outlined in the library's longrange plan of service;
- (6) periodically evaluates the effectiveness of the library's programs, services and collections to address community needs, as outlined in the library's long-range plan of service;
- (7) is open the following scheduled hours:

Population	Minimum Weekly Hours Open
Up to 500	12
500 – 2,499	20
2,500 – 4,999	25
5,000 – 14,999	35
15,000 – 24,999	40
25,000 – 99,999	55
100,000 and above	60

- (8) maintains a facility that addresses community needs, as outlined in the library's long-range plan of service, including adequate space, lighting, shelving, seating, power and data infrastructure, and a public restroom;

- (9) provides programming to address community needs, as outlined in the library’s long-range plan of service;
- (10) provides a circulation system that facilitates access to the local library collection and other library catalogs; and provides equipment, technology, and internet connectivity to address community needs and facilitate access to information;
- (11) provides access to current library information in print and online, facilitating the understanding of library services, operations and governance; information provided online shall include the standards referenced in paragraphs (1) through (5) of this subdivision;
- (12) employs a paid director in accordance with the provisions of section 90.8 of this Part;
- (13) provides library staff with annual technology training, appropriate to their position, to address community needs, as outlined in the library’s long-range plan of service; and
- (14) establishes and maintains partnerships with other educational, cultural or community organizations which enable the library to address the community’s needs, as outlined in the library’s long-range plan of service.

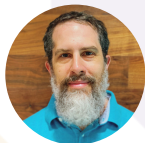
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
